#### 4.PLANNING

2 Duncan Street (West Blacket): Application withdrawn.

**Minto Hotel** (16/17/18 Minto Street): Initial application has been withdrawn after a considerable number of objections, and a revised application put in. The architects have requested a meeting with representatives of the committee. Noted:

frontage much improved: restoring original doorway, and lead framing glass between the houses;
back townhouses some improvements: stone facings and slightly more set back from boundary wall.
However house footprint has been made deeper to include garages, creating large terraces at first

floor level with privacy implications. -boundary walls not mentioned.

-no neighbours' notification of revised application received.

The Committee also noted the recent Evening News article quoting Councillor Cameron Rose's support for the project and dismissal of "a few objections". The committee expressed concern that Councillor Rose has not consulted any residents on this matter.
